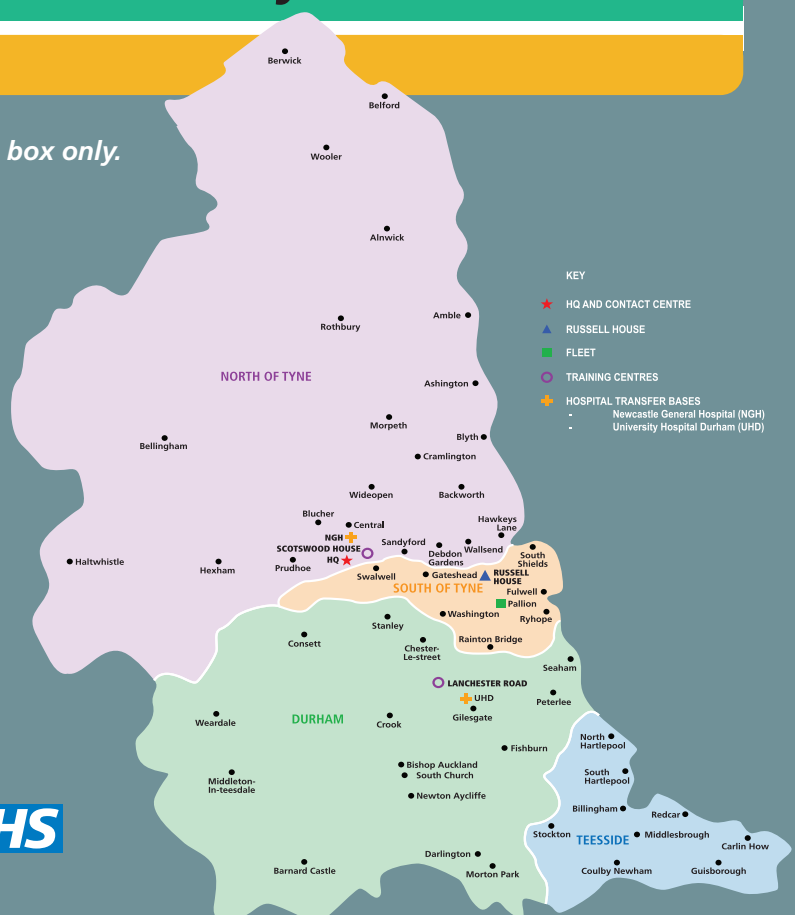

- *A person who has verbally or physically abused any member of NHS staff, patient, carer or registered volunteers, or has been issued with a Personal Safety and Security Warning Letter by the Trust*
